



PREFECTURE OF KAVALA:

FERTILE LAND, RICH SEA





From the lagoon of Keramoti to the foothills of Mount Paggaio and from the valley of Nestos to the city center, the prefecture of Kavala is a rich place, full of flavors and aromas.

The scales, of course, lean towards fish and seafood

In the great plains of Kavala Prefecture, which is full of crops, endless straight lines between scattered fields with all the colors of the rainbow: Yellow of sunflower, green of pepper, red of tomato, violet of blueberry and orange of lotus.





WHAT DOES THE PREFECTURE OF KAVALA PRODUCE?

Juicy fruits like kiwi, watermelons, pomegranates, peaches, apricots, cherries, apples, pears, grapes, blueberries and tasty vegetables from all kinds, such as asparagus, tomatoes, peppers and more.

Also, grains, legumes (mainly beans), wheat, corn and rice.

ALSO SNAILS!

There are two species of snails in the area: the dark brown and the white of the mountain - white due to the limestone soils in the mountains.





EXCELLENT QUALITY VIRGIN OIL, OLIVES, PICKLES IN ALL AREA

In Thassos island we find olive oil of Protected Geographical Indication, olives, of Protected Designation of Origin and honey

(from pine trees).





VAST FIELDS

Kavala is surrounded by rich and fertile plains. On the one hand the plain on the border with the prefecture of Drama and on the east the plain of Chrysoupoli. Many farmers have turned to the so-called "energy plants", mainly sunflower and soybeans - plants that are subsidized by European programs and used to produce alternative fuels, such as biodiesel.





THE STRENGTH IN UNITY

Thassos olive oil and olives, asparagus, kiwi, grapes, watermelon and many other products are exported to almost all over the world by EAS Kavala. Asparagus is grown in more and more fields, while the plans include the export of cherries and pears.



LIVESTOCK

Milk and meat production (beef, pork, lamb, goats, poultry), eggs, yogurt and cheese including feta cheese.





FROM GOLD MINES TO GOLD IN A GLASS

Many wineries are gathered around Mount Paggaio, there is a significant production of excellent quality of ouzo and tsipouro as well, while honey, almonds, chestnuts, hazelnuts and walnuts are produced on the mountains.









FISH AND ALL KINDS OF SEAFOOD

Fine mussels, fresh, big and fleshed from the mussel farms of Keramoti and blue crabs from the fish farm of the area, sea bream, mullet, sea bass and eels as well.





The 60 fishing boats that approach the fish market every morning unload about 10,000 tons of fish per year and are one of the main pillars of the local economy. Anchovies and sardines in abundance, but also red mullets, octopuses, shrimps, squid and any other fish allowed by the season.



Sweet water fish also: Trout and smoked trouts at river Nestos and Kefalari





WINE WITH A HISTORY

Sea breeze, clay and limestone in the soil of Mount Paggaio and a long history favor the cultivation of vines at the foot of the mountain.

More than 20 wineries operate in the prefecture of Kavala.



Vivlia Chora vineyard, for example, produces 11 excellent wines to organic standards and the total production reaches 600,000 bottles per year.

The people of the estate discovered an unknown local variety, which has not yet been identified or given an official name.

Nevertheless, some bottles were bottled with the name "Biblinos" - a name given to the wine by the ancients of Paggaio.






A UNIQUE PLANTATION IN KAVALA PREFECTURE

Prinos North and Epsilon are currently the only producing fields of ...crude oil in Greece.

The fields are located in the Gulf of Kavala, 18 km south of the mainland of Northern Greece, in water depth of 30 to 38 metres.
